Code of Conduct

Attendance at all games and practices is important. Players should attend all scheduled practices unless prior approval has been granted by the coach. The “no practice, no start” rule will be in effect for all unapproved absences.

Parents must arrange for the timely pick-up of athletes after each practice and game.

At no time will a player and a coach be alone and out of sight. All disciplinary action between a player and a coach will require two adults present.

All participants (coaches, parents, players, and families) are expected to exercise God-honoring attitudes and behaviors, both on and off the court to support the Statement of Faith. While we will all do this imperfectly, one of the main purposes of CKHAA is to help one another grow in our Christ-likeness.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law (Galatians 5:22-23).

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up, that it may benefit those who listen. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgives you (Ephesians 4:29-32).

Abstain from all appearance of evil (I Thessalonians 5:22).

With the purpose of Christ-likeness in mind, the following behaviors are considered unacceptable:

- A. Defiance or disrespect of authority, including coaches, officials, or referees
- B. Displays of violence or blatant disregard for safety
- C. Ridiculing of one’s own players or another team’s players
- D. Profanity or vulgarity
- E. Obscenity
- F. Possession of literature, pictures, or recordings presenting an indecent or immoral activity.
- G. Disorderly or destructive activity
- H. Gossip/rumors/slander
- I. Dishonesty
- J. Theft
- K. Gambling
- L. Use of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs
- M. Immodest dress
- N. Any other activities deemed undesirable by the Coach or Board of Directors

Conflict may arise between any participant of any age (Coach/Player; Coach/Parent, Parent/Parent, etc). When this is the case, please reference the Central Kansas Homeschool Athletic Association’s Grievances, Appeals, and Conflict Resolution section in the CKHAA Handbook.
